Christmas assistance includes Angel Tree gifts for children of qualified families for ages 12 years of age and under.

Who is eligible?

A) Applicants must **meet at least one** of the following income criteria:

- At least one adult member of the household is employed or has become unemployed in the last 12 months.
- Receiving unemployment benefits, A qualifying adult receiving (SSI) supplemental security income, (SSDI) disability benefits, retirement pension, or foster care aid.
- OR head of household is currently enrolled fulltime student.

B) Applicants must not exceed the household income guidelines listed below:

To Apply: You must bring the following documents:

- Picture ID for all adults in household
- Social Security cards for all members of household (including adults)
- Birth certificates for all children in the household (or legal proof of custody)
- Verification of all household income which can include: wages (last 3 pay stubs), TANF, SNAP, child support, social security/disability award letters, unemployment benefits statement, school tuition letter, etc. A self-employed individual must provide completed tax returns from previous year.
- Verification of all household expenses: utilities bill with service address, car insurance, car note, utility allowance, medical bills, etc.
- Proof of residency: lease, deed, or mortgage statement
