## *About Our Shelters ...*

Each evening, as many as 150 men, women and children seek refuge in our shelter. Services consist of two programs—emergency overnight and short-term, case managed shelter.

Many who utilize emergency shelter stay for a few days and find a resolution to their housing crisis. Others have more challenges and employ the assistance offered by our case management staff during their short-term shelter stay. Focused on returning to sustainable housing, clients receive life skills classes, case management, as well as referrals to other community programs.

Currently our shelter space for women and families can accept six adult single women and five family units in the program. Fourteen individuals (any combination of women and children) can be accepted for emergency shelter on a first-come, first served basis.
