CLIENT CONSENT & RELEASE OF INFORMATION FOR DATA SHARING

Please read the following statements and make sure you have had an opportunity to have your questions answered.

This agency is part of MFIN (Mid Florida Information Network). MFIN is a system that uses computers to collect information about homelessness. MFIN operates over the Internet and uses many security protections to keep your information safe. Because many service providers across Citrus, Lake, Hernando, and Sumter counties use MFIN, your information will be shared with other service providers from which you might be seeking services. No personally identifying information will be shared by MFIN with any department of the State of Florida or the Federal Government.

The agency is asking your permission to share information with other agencies in the planning and delivery of services to you. Basic information about you (and any minor children accompanying you) including your name, gender, race ethnicity, birth date, and veteran status, will be available to Partner Agencies through MFIN for seven years from the last date of service.

By signing this form, you are consenting to allow us to share information with other agencies in the planning and delivery of services to you. Basic information including your name, gender, race, ethnicity, birth date, and veteran status, will be available to Partner Agencies through MFIN for seven years from the last date of service.

You may cancel this consent at any given time by written request to this agency, but the cancellation will not be retroactive.
