Worth Avenue, at the Boca Raton Museum gift shop, in Miami on Brickell Key, and in NYC at the Carlyle and Mandarin Oriental Hotels, in Southampton, and Roslyn (NY), as well as the Morris Museum in NJ, and in Greenwich, CT, and the North Shore of the Chicagoland area. Internationally her line of clothing sells in Monaco, St Tropez, Forte dei Marmi and Lugano. They were recently featured in the goods section of Muses and Visionaries magazine as well as Venu magazine.
