**A MESSAGE OF HOPE**

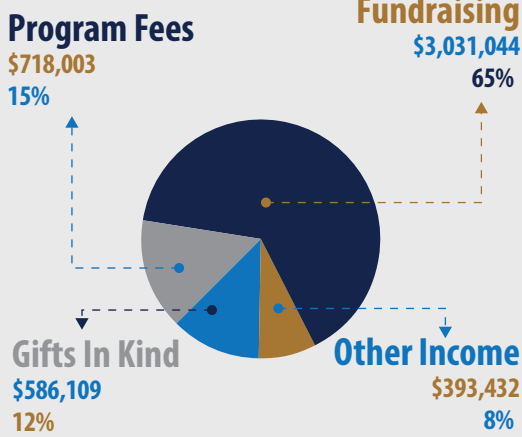

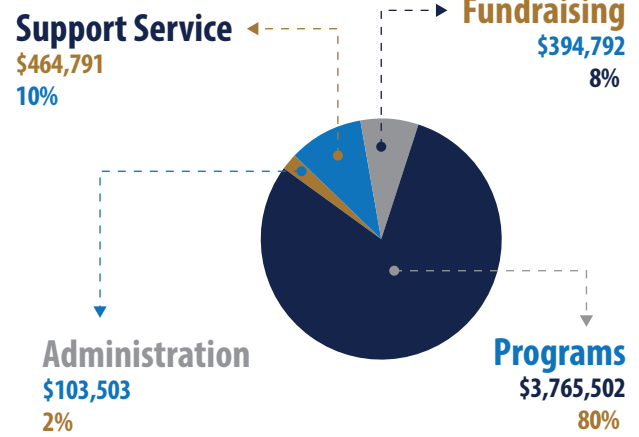

- 7 WEEKS Summer Camp



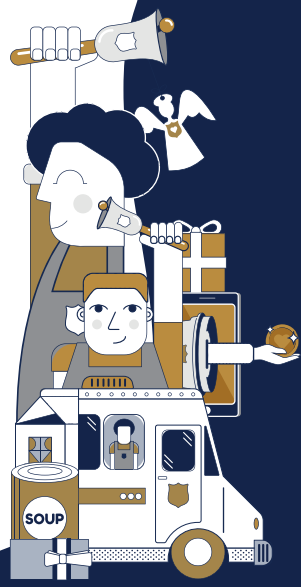
### CHILD DEVELOPMENT CENTER

- \$429,500 distributed via gift cards in Collier County as part of Ian Response efforts

- \$300,000 distributed for Appliances and Car Replacement and Rental Assistance as part of Ian Recover efforts

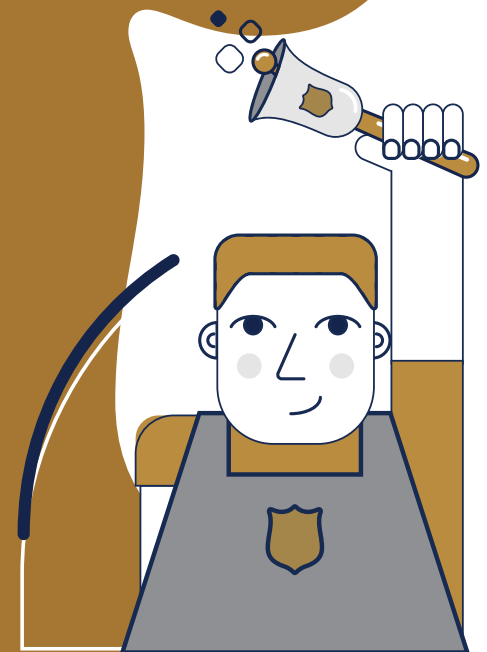
