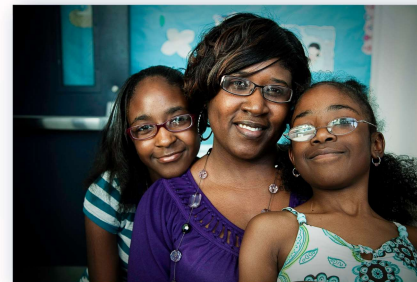


## The Venue
